We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your generous support of our annual Ramble Run. This year we had 91 participants of all ages. Despite the inclement weather all participants completed their runs/walks.

Your donations go to our scholarship program which provides monies to a graduating senior of each of our high schools. (Canajoharie, Fort Plain, St. Johnsville) Last year we were able to increase our scholarships to 500.00 per school. Due to your donations this year's scholarships remained at 500.00.

We are currently working on a new program that is geared to providing "Nooks" for our school libraries to lend out to students who may have a visual, hearing, physical or learning disability. With the Nook, assigned readings can be downloaded and text can be enlarged or, in the near future, changed to speech. It is our hope, as well, to draw the non-reader into the world of books because of the technology alone. We have a pilot program in the Canajoharie High School at present and the feedback is very positive.

These projects are in addition to our ongoing programs that aid the sight and hearing impaired in our communities.
