

Limited Visitation Guidelines for Families

Indoor Visiting Hours 1:00pm-7:00pm Monday-Friday

Outdoor Visiting Hours 9:00am-4:00pm Monday-Friday (*weather permitting*)

Visitors must always wear a facemask covering mouth and nose and follow social distancing while in the facility.

No more than 10% of residents shall have visitors at any one time (MAX. 11)

Visitor Screening Process prior to access to resident

- Screened for signs/symptoms of COVID-19
- Temperature Checks
- Questions regarding international travel or travel to states under Commissioner's travel advisory

Visitation will be refused if individuals exhibit any COVID-19 symptoms or do not pass screening questions

Visiting areas are limited to:

- outdoors, weather permitting
- inside, in a well-ventilated space
 - no more than 10 individuals socially distancing
 - wearing a facemask

Visitation strictly prohibited in resident rooms or care areas

- Visitation areas will be cleaned and disinfected after each visit
- Visitation areas will be monitored for social distancing
- Hand sanitizer will be available for visitors

Limited visitation includes but is not limited to

- Family members
- Loved ones
- Representatives from LTC ombudsman program (LTCOP)
- Resident advocacy organizations

2 visitors per resident at any one time

Visitors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older

COVID-19 positive residents, residents with COVID-19 symptoms or residents in a 14-day quarantine/observation are not eligible for visits
